CHEESE

The CSU Cheese Factory, which has been in operation since August 98, is producing a range of gourmet cheese seen nowhere else in Australia. This Farmhouse Cheese Factory uses only the highest quality milk from our own dairy 3km away. Apart from its Classic range of handmade cheddars, including a very mature Classic Cheddar, the factory produces a range of cheeses with Australian native flavours. These include Native Bush Tomato, Native Mint, Native Forest Berry, Native Pepperleaf and Native Lemon Myrtle. Other flavours are currently being trialled. Ricotta is also produced using traditional Italian methods.

All the above cheese is available through the Cellar Door Sales of the CSU Winery and Knights Meats in Wagga Wagga as well as selected Coles, Woolworths and Safeway stores.
